

GARBAGE SEPARATION AND COLLECTION

Please separate your garbage in to the specified categories, and **take it out by 8:30 a.m. on the appointed days and place.**

- ※ Municipal or village offices can provide you with the information on your appointed place.
- ※ If you are going to dispose a large amount of garbage, for example, when you move house, you are required to take it to EDOSAKI CHIHO EISEI-DOBOKU KUMIAI.

Garbage is divided into “Burnable”, Bottles-Glass”, “Metal”, “Plastic Bottles” and “Bulky”.

“Burnable”, “Bottles-glass”, “Metal” garbage should be packed in the designated bags, as shown below.

- ※ The specified bags are on sale in supermarkets, convenience stores and retail outlets.



The Category includes “Burnable”

Kitchen garbage	Papers	Cloth, leather	Trees, branches	Plastics

NOTE

- **Kitchen garbage** should be well drained.
- **Cooking oil** **should be absorbed** into cloth or paper or solidified.
- Excretions from **Paper diapers** should be removed.
- **Papers, magazines, cardboard** should be tied up crosswise.
 - ※ **Corrugated cardboard** should be folded up to about 50 by 50cm.
- **Tree branches** should be cut to less than 50cm long and less than 5cm thick, and be bundled together.
 - ※ **No more than 5 bundles of trees and branches will be accepted.**





Glass, bottles

Empty Bottles	Glass
Sake bottles· beer bottles· softdrink bottles 	Glasses· sheet glass· mirrors· pots· fluorescent lights 

NOTE

- Empty bottles: Remove the caps and wash the bottles out.
- Broken glass: Wrap it up in newspaper as it is dangerous.

Metal

Empty cans	Small household appliances	Metal	China
Soft drink cans· Spray cans· Gas canisters for table stove 	Electric fans· Rice cookers· Hair dryers· Telephones·Toaster 	Pans·teakettles· Knives·Frying pans· Umbrellas· Dry batteries 	Bowls·Dishes· Earthen pots· Milk-white glass 

NOTE

- Spray cans, gas canisters, etc. : There is a danger of explosion. Cans should be emptied.
- Soft drink cans: They should be emptied and washed out.
- Edged tools: They are dangerous. Wrap them up in newspaper.

Plastic bottles

Remove the caps and labels, wash the bottles out, crush them and then take out to the designated place.

Bottles for soft drinks· soy sauce· sweet cooking sake· sake, etc.






Bulky garbage

This type of garbage **is not collected** and needs to be brought directly to the EDOSAKI CHIHO EISEI DOBOKU KUMIAI.

NOTE

- Mattress, Sofas, etc.: Remove springs.
- Stoves, Heaters, etc.: Remove kerosene and dry batteries.
- Boilers: Remove insulation.

Taking garbage to EDOSAKI CHIHO EISEIDOBOKU KUMIAI

Reception desk

Monday to Friday 8:40 AM– 4:00 PM

Saturday 8:40 AM–11:30 PM

※ Garbage is not accepted in the afternoon of Saturday, and on Sunday and holidays.

Charges

1. Handling charge
General garbage from homes: 10 yen per kilogram
General garbage from companies: 15 yen per kilogram
2. Specific household appliances (TVs, Refrigerator, Washing machine, Air conditioner):
Only accepted when refused by shops or retailers and must have “household appliances recycle ticket” attached.
Transportation to the specified disposal facility: 2,000 yen per item.

NOTE

Large quantities of garbage, resulting from house demolitions, moves, etc, must be informed in advance. If you have any questions, please ask.

Some kind of garbage may not be accepted when appropriate disposal is rendered difficult.

※ Garbage resulting from house demolitions must be informed one week in advance.

Garbage not accepted

Concerning the following items, please contact the sellers or ask a disposal firm.

(Examples)

- Roof tiles, thatch
- New building materials; Plasterboard, Insulation
- Roots of trees, incineration ashes
- Medical waste
- Residual cans with Agrochemicals
- Motorcycles, tires, Batteries
- Gas cylinders
- Corrugated plastic sheets
- Large refrigerators, Vending machines
- Sink, Bathtub, Toilets
- Industrial polystyrene
- Oil, Paint
- Concrete-Blocks
- Electric cables and wires
- Extinguishers
- PVC pipe
- Agricultural plastic sheets
- Personal computers
